Policy Statement:

Mitigate risk for head and other significant injuries on the ski hill for all CADS Alberta members.

Procedure

It is recognized that the on snow environment in which our entire membership works and participates in has many risks associated with it, including but not limited to skiing at high speed, demonstrating technical elements in gates or in drills, setting up or managing training and race venues as well as being hit by others on the hill.

Participants and volunteers are required to wear certified alpine or snowboard helmets at all times. CADS Alberta is now making it mandatory for their staff and Board to wear helmets while on the hill as a preventative measure. CADS Alberta recommends that CADS Alberta Zones also follow the same policy measures. Participants and volunteers are becoming increasingly exposed to legal action as a result of on hill related accidents.
